<u>Vírago 1100 Pump Cover</u>

Message from Keith Iddon C4

I have obtained a fuel pump cover for my 1100 Virago which is made from polished stainless steel.

I have been in contact with the guy I bought it from and he actually makes these. If your original plastic one is cracking at the mounting point one of these would make a more durable replacement.

If you are interested in getting one please let me know. The price would probably be around the £40 mark depending on the cost of the stainless steel. A new plastic one is £55 upwards if you can get one.
