Bike preparation

Now is the time to start thinking about your bike ready for the coming season, if we have a season that is, looking grim at the moment !!

Dont leave it until the last minute so if you have it serviced by a dealer make plans for that now as they get busy as the season approaches.

If you DIY, change the oil, filter and either clean of change the air filter, I dont check my plugs every year but maybe a reminder if it hasn't been done for a while, check the condition of the brake pads, top up the master cylinders and check the seals on the calipers. Check the condition of the tyres and pressures [you will be surprised how much pressure is lost when the bike is standing]. Ensure all nuts and bolts are tight, check lights and indicators. There are lots of other 'checks 'you can do including lubricate and grease moving parts, linkages etc.

Finally give the bike a good clean and polish, including polish and protect those shiny surfaces, cylinder fin edges as they can corrode very quietly and then look ugly.

Anything you do will be helpful in the end.

I look forward to seeing all those shiny well maintained bikes out on the road in the near future.
